

Students to attend school Feb. 15 to make up for Feb. 1

Schools will be open Monday, Feb. 15 for a regular student day to make up for the day students missed Monday, Feb. 1 when schools were closed because of winter weather.

Feb. 15 was originally scheduled as a holiday for students so that teachers could take part in professional development activities. The day is one of the days the district designated as a make-up day when the calendar was developed.

“Feb. 15 is the next scheduled make-up day on the calendar, and we believe it’s important to use the make-up day because we still face the possibility of winter weather and more missed days,” Superintendent Gene Moore said.

State law requires schools to be in session 180 days a year.

Teachers will make up the Feb. 15 professional development day later in the semester.
